Our Commitment

Reduce or eliminate the use of plastic packaging where possible.

Support improvements to the plastic waste reduction system by engaging innovators to help support development of environmentally preferable options to plastics and promote reuse and expand recycling capabilities.

Our Strategic Direction

We shall ensure that our operations have suitable recycling systems available to capture plastic waste.

We shall raise awareness amongst our staff with training of waste reduction and energy efficient practices.

We shall encourage all stakeholders to reduce the use of single-use plastics and ensuring that the recycling systems are available internally.

We shall continuously improve tracking of sustainability metrics throughout our operations and supply chain.

We shall partner with our suppliers to operate sustainably, reduce waste, and encourage minimisation of non-essential single-use plastics and ensure that these are incorporated into new business agreements.
